

## Acute Occlusive Mesenteric Ischemia : Superior Mesenteric Artery Thrombosis with Celiac Artery Thrombosis –A Rare Case Report

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### Abstract:

We want to report here a case of Superior mesenteric artery thrombosis with celiac artery thrombosis confirmed by CECT ABDOMEN + mesenteric angiography. A 32 year old male patient admitted to our hospital with abdominal pain and severe guarding. Abdominal CT showed complete celiac artery thrombosis with superior mesenteric artery thrombosis. On surgical exploration, gangrenous bowel loops of distal jejunum and ileum were found. Histologically, resected specimen shows features of total necrosis of mucosa extending upto Finally a rare case of Superior mesenteric artery thrombosis along with celiac artery thrombosis has been achieved confirmed by CECT ABDOMEN with mesenteric angiography.
