Abstract:

The most common orthodontic problems that braces can correct are malocclusion or bite problems that are mostly genetic problem, Crowding is a common orthodontic problem , crowded teeth can be unattractive and difficult to clean , Protruded teeth can be unattractive and more prone to damage , Anterior crossbite in which the lower front teeth protrude beyond the upper teeth , Deep bite in which upper front cover the lower teeth , Posterior cross bite in cases where upper jaw is too narrow and lower jaw usually swings to one side, Open bite in cases where some teeth do not meet .
